

Cercidium floridum

(Syn. Parkinsonia florida)

BLUE PALO VERDE

Native durability provides shade. These trees are one of the important native trees that dominate our arborescent Sonoran Desert. Adaptable to many desert designs, all Palo Verdes have characteristically green bark, this one has blue-green foliage that provides its common name. Moderate to fast growing to about 30 ft., most typically multi-trunked with low, dense branching habit. Deep infrequent watering keeps these trees well rooted and blooming well once they are established. Yellow blooms cover the tree canopy in spring.
