Eremophila maculata 'Valentine'

Tough Australian shrubs giving great color. This selection is an upright growing plant that produces dark red tubular flowers starting in winter with full bloom occurring in mid-February, hence the cultivar name. Small, dark green to burgundy tinged leaves provide a dark silhouette for other complimentary plants. For reference, it may be helpful to know that all Eremophila sp. are distantly related to Leucophyllum sp. and most require the same cultural care and environments as TX Sage, although most Emu bushes are not as cold tolerant. Emu bush are quite adaptable and will accept more regular watering in captive landscapes. They are equally happy in low deserts as they are in coastal regions. Just remember that the more water they get the faster and larger they usually grow.
