PLANT DETAILS


Hardenbergia violacea

LILAC VINE, OR AUSTRALIAN LILAC VINE

Dark green handsome lance leaves with purple flowers.
Evergreen vines needing support and some afternoon shade. Long, lush dark green lance-shaped leaves on woody stems with long strings of amethyst purple flowers that appear from winter to early spring. Adaptable to heat with ample summer irrigation in well-drained soils. Maintenance should include proper soil amendments in alkaline soils to keep foliage healthy. These twining vines will grow as tall and wide as their supports will allow. Pruning in late spring to remove old flower strands is only regular maintenance they require.
