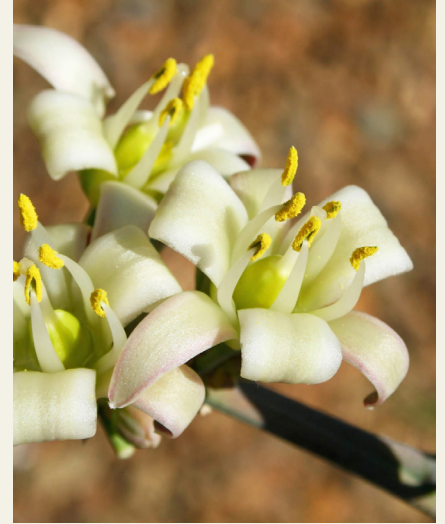




# Hesperaloe funifera

## GIANT HESPERALOE

Bold vertical accent plant for big spaces. Succulent accent plant that grows 4 ft. long unarmed leaves from a central base. Strong white curling filaments peel naturally from the leaf margins to create a wild wispy appearance, at least when viewed up close. They are quite heat and drought tolerant requiring only periodic moisture once mature. Avoid planting too deep, as this can lead to crown rot. Once mature, these evergreen plants will shoot up tall multi-branched dramatic flower stalks to more than 12 ft. high. Each branch holds cream colored blooms with recurved petals, while attractive the bold size and height of the stalks are what is so impressive about these long-lived large accent plants. While they are not fast growers, when planting, put them in open spaces with wide individual spacing. Good for freeway right of way, parks, golf courses, natural desert designs, and even home or commercial landscapes as long as appropriate spacing is followed.
