

Pachycereus schottii f. monstrosus

(Syn. Lophocereus schottii 'Monstrosus')

TOTEM POLE

These are spineless, columnar cacti, with slow wide growth habit. These are genetically mutated, attractively lumpy, and bumpy form of the Lophocereus schottii - Sanita cacti. Well-drained soils and time will allow them to grow into large, stately and dramatic looking plants. They perform well in containers or in ground mixed with other low water use natives.
