## PLANT DETAILS

## Pithecellobium flexicaule

(Syn. Ebenopsis ebano) TEXAS EBONY

Medium sized trees with dark green leaves. These are moderate to slow growing trees native to South Texas. They have short compound emerald green leaves along zig-zagged, thorny branches. In spring, they flower with cream to white colored puff-ball like flowers the set ornamental, long wide woody seed pods. Ebony trees form dense canopies, so they do work well as small to medium sized shade trees, but they take time and a bit of training to get there. Give them moderate, regular irrigation, especially during summer months until trees become established, then deep monthly watering to maintain their lush foliage and flowering ability.
