








# Rosa x 'Iceberg'

## 'ICEBERG' FLORIBUNDA ROSE

*Floriferous floribunda rose with virtually no thorns. 'Iceberg' rose has been gracing gardens since 1958 and remains one of the most popular, and durable blooming, heat tolerant roses. These shrubs are covered with emerald green, glossy disease resistant foliage. They have tight buds that unfurl to 2-3 in. wide, pure white to a white blend flowers in a clustered form. Plants are long blooming with a shrubby, upright growth habit that make them ideal for informal hedge, border plants, or container gardens on patios. They are one of the easiest roses to cultivate. "One of the world's top ten favorite roses" by the World Rose Society Federation. Regular annual pruning when dormant, fertilizing spring into summer, and consistent watering, especially during the hottest summer months keeps them growing well, looking good and full of blooms.*
