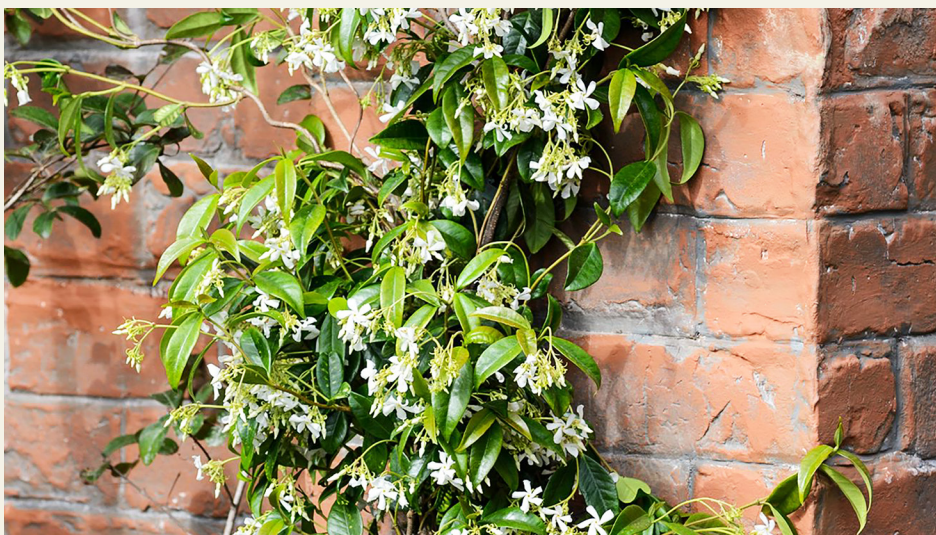


# Trachelospermum jasminoides

## STAR JASMINE

*Evergreen vines for shade with intense flower fragrance.* These durable evergreen vines require support and will not attach to vertical surfaces. Trellises, arbors, guide wire, or fences are all they need. Leaves are large pointed ovals of dark shiny green with light lime green new growth. Blooms are small, star shaped white and appear in masses during spring emitting an intoxicating scent. They can be used as groundcovers, clambering over boulders or to cover slopes or bare ground under shade trees. Star Jasmine does not perform well in full sun exposures. Morning sun, 1/2 day or filtered sun in low deserts is ideal. Moderate to ample water to start with mature plants tolerating regular irrigation system watering as they become established and mature. Minimal maintenance and some selective trimming to train. Be aware, when cut, the stem exudes a milky sap that can irritate skin.
