



Cereus forbesii 'Spiralis'

TWISTED CACTUS

This captivating cactus demands a second glance. No other species in the cacti family has this unique growth pattern. Its twisting, swirling bright green columns, delicately accented with small spines, create an illusion of motion – hence its fitting moniker, the 'Twisted Cactus.' Originating from Brazil, modern hybridization has refined this species, revealing echoes of its lineage from the *Cereus peruvianus* cacti. Mirroring its parent's candelabra-like growth, it can reach heights of 5-6 feet under ideal conditions. Come late spring, it unfurls spectacular white blossoms tinged with pink. Thrives in full or partial sun and is drought-tolerant once established. Monthly deep watering from May to August is ample, but shield it from temperatures dropping below 28°F in the winter.
